SECOND-BEST MONTH EVER BODES WELL FOR CU24 CONVERSION

September 28, 2006, Tallahassee, Fla. – Despite being entrenched in a major switch-processor conversion, Credit Union 24 is still experiencing record transaction numbers, with August producing the EFT network's second-best month ever in volume. Not counting "on-us" transactions, Credit Union 24 routed more than 16.7 million transactions through the credit union-owned network in August. The announcement, following news that Credit Union 24 signed 17 new credit unions to the EFT cooperative so far in 2006, helps reaffirm the network's confidence in a smooth and transparent processor conversion. In November of 2005, Credit Union 24 announced its intent to convert switch-processing services from Fiserv EFT to Fifth Third Processing Solutions.

"We're thrilled by these numbers," said Credit Union 24 President and CEO James Park. "We expected our growth to flatten somewhat during the conversion, so we're quite pleased that we continue to show increases in membership and transaction volume. I see it as a vote of confidence in the network during the conversion, and I'm grateful that our members recognize the value of their network and the opportunities ahead."

Credit Union 24 is a flexible, member-owned, full-service ATM and POS network with multiple processor links, hundreds of thousands of POS locations and more than 100,000 ATM terminals across the country. Credit Union 24's voluntary CU HERE surcharge-free program is part of one of the largest fee-free ATM networks in the country, and includes both on- and off-premise surcharge-free terminals.
