Guerry Re-elected as Chairman of Credit Union 24 Network

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – August 6, 2009 – Credit Union 24, the country's largest credit union-owned ATM and point-of-sale (POS) network, announced that its Board of Directors has unanimously re-elected Mansel Guerry for a second term as Chairman of the organization. Also re-elected at the Credit Union 24's recent reorganization meeting were: Chris Leggett, Vice Chairman, and Bradley Blake, Secretary/Treasurer. The meeting followed the corporation's Annual Meeting where three incumbents, elected by shareholding credit unions, were seated. The incumbents included: Guerry, Blake, and Alvin J. Cowans.

Chairman Mansel Guerry is president of Mississippi Employees Federal Credit Union, headquartered in Ridgeland, Miss., which has grown from one to three branch locations under his direction. He has worked with credit unions for more than 20 years and was elected treasurer and vice-chairman of Credit Union 24's founding Board of Directors in 1998. Prior to his service on the Credit Union 24 Board of Directors, Guerry worked as the primary marketing contact for the network in Mississippi.

Chris Leggett, Vice Chairman, is President/CEO of LGE Community Credit Union, headquartered in Marietta, Georgia. He has more than 20 years of credit union experience and leadership. Leggett started his career at First Florida Credit Union, holding a variety of positions ranging from information systems manager and vice president of branch operations to chief financial officer. Leggett has also served as national sales director for PSCU Financial Services.

Bradley Blake, treasurer/secretary of the Credit Union 24 Board of Directors, is president/CEO of Florida State University Credit Union, headquartered in Tallahassee, Fla. In his 14 years of service at FSU Credit Union, he has served as chief information officer, vice president of administration and executive vice president prior to becoming president and CEO in 2003.

Alvin J. Cowans has been president/CEO of McCoy Federal Credit Union, headquartered in Orlando, Fla., since 1985. In his 30 years of experience in the financial industry he has been named to the Official Registry of the "Outstanding Young Men of America" in 1981 and the "Who's Who of American Business Leaders" in 1991. In 2007, he was recognized in the "Who's Who in America's Credit Unions."
